AHIAH CENTER FOR SPIRITUAL LIVING GRAND OPENING!

"CONTINUING THE SACRED PLACE"

Pasadena, CA – October 17, 2017 Ahiah Center for Spiritual Living Pasadena joyfully presents the official celebration of their recently acquired facility at 150 N. El Molino in Pasadena. The Grand Opening events will take place over 3 days beginning Friday, October 21 and go through the weekend, Saturday 22 and Sunday, Oct 23. The Center is located in Pasadena's Playhouse district between Colorado and Walnut / Lake and Los Robles.

Ahiah Center for Spiritual Living is part of the Centers for Spiritual Living which is a merger of United Centers for Spiritual Living and Church of Religious Science International. Informally known as Ahiah or Ahiah CSL, the Center occupied the west corner of El Molino and Curson at 277 N. El Molino for over 70 years. Last year they moved only a block and a half south to the former Self Realization Center, founded by Parahamansa Yogananda. The move was quite extensive, with the sorting through and moving of over 70 years of accumulated history at the 277 El Molino address. Meanwhile, renovations, additions and code compliance construction was taking place at the 150 N. El Molino address. This is the first relocation in its entire history since its 1942 Charter. Originally chartered as The Pasadena Church of Religious Science, the churches name has changed over the years, but the philosophy and spiritual principles of a Universal Presence have remained consistent throughout their initial charter in 1942. What started as a group meeting at the local Women's Club in the 1940's the Center continues to serve the spiritual seekers in Pasadena, CA and the surrounding areas. and has continued to grow and be a vital part of the community for over 70 years.

When he learned the Pasadena Self Realization Center was inactive, current Senior Minister, Rev. Charles David Rose held the vision to move Ahiah to their facility at 150 N. El Molino. Rev. Rose would sometimes stand in front of SRC in prayer and hold the vision for Ahiah to move into the sacred space. After years of the SRC declining offers, they graciously accepted the Ahiah offer in the spirit of Continuing the Sacred Space. Rev. Charles Rose says that the church's internal focus on this new journey is three-fold, "We definitely want to honor our past, become increasingly active in the present and be an inspiration for the future".

This new multi-million dollar facility was made possible by strategic investments and financial commitments from the congregation.

Added Rose, "This new home allows Ahiah to expand our ministry, add new programs and activities and serve our community better – that is already happening and continues to grow."

Ahiah Center for Spiritual Living offers a full roster of classes from the Center for Spiritual Living curriculum, has expand their ministries to include a Business Networking Group; Men's Group; Women's Circle; Yoga; Tai Chi and guest Meditation Facilitators.
